If you do so when people are laid back, it will probably be done in an Engelbert Humperdinck / Frank Sinatra / Neil Diamond Kind of voice.

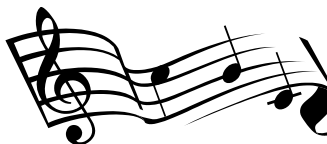
Later when people are dancing the Samba, do not be surprised if it's done in Latin American style.

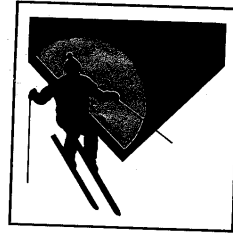

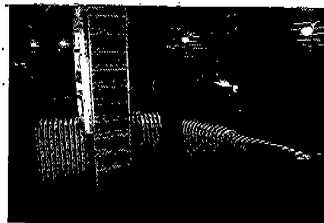
